This privacy policy sets out how International Camp Suisse uses and protects any information that you give when you use this website.

What we collect

Your personal details and those of your children as submitted via the 'request a brochure' or 'join our mailing list' buttons on the website or on our camper registration form or staff application form.

What we do with the information we gather

Camp Suisse will collect and store your information for the purpose of delivering services to you that you have requested. We will never pass your information to any party outside of Camp Suisse unless required by law to do so. We will never sell or lease your personal information.

If you have signed up for the newsletter or if you have submitted a completed registration form to us with payment for a summer camp we will include you on our mailing list for our regular newsletter and occasional news of Camp Suisse promotions and offers. If you have worked at Camp Suisse you will also be included automatically on our mailing list. You can opt out of this communication permanently at any time.

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.
